Sixth Form Scholarships

Introduction

King's College awards a few prestigious Sir Roger Fry academic scholarships to pupils who wish to study in the Sixth Form at King's College, Soto de Viñuelas, Madrid.

All applicants must complete the school admissions process for Year 12 entry and are committed to completing their sixth form schooling in King's College.

Studies offered:

Two academic years' study, Lower and Upper Sixth Forms (English National Curriculum or International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme, Years 12 & 13) in King's College, Soto de Viñuelas, Madrid.

Academic Sir Roger Fry Scholarships: These Scholarships are focussed on academic standards. Successful applicants should do well in the entrance assessment and interview, but they must also have an excellent Year 11 academic profile.

Duration of Scholarship:

Two academic years (2022-2024).

Value of the Scholarship:

A full or partial scholarship equivalent to academic fees will be offered for both school years. Under no circumstance will the scholarships be exchangeable for money. The scholarships do not cover boarding accommodation fees.

Candidates who may apply:

- Pupils who intend starting GCE 'A' Level or IB studies in September 2021 having completed GCSE or (I)GCSE examinations or their equivalent in other educational systems.
- All applicants must take the competitive entrance assessment.
- All applicants must speak English to at least B2/C1 level to access the courses at King's College Soto, which are taught in English.

Applications from Non King's College Pupils

Non King's College pupils should supply the following information with their application form:

- 1. A certificate from the candidate's present school showing most recent qualifications obtained in Year 10 and Year 11 of the "English National Curriculum" or equivalent. The student must have achieved the highest possible marks on at least 70% of the subjects taken at their school. The internal evaluation system used by the candidate's school must be explained to King's College in detail.
- 2. Supporting documents from the candidate's current school, club, association, or the like, describing the candidate's extra-curricular activities, abilities and achievements, contribute to success in the process. Possible activities may include sports, music, drama, community service contributions, adventure activities, etc. We require additional information to be submitted with the application.

Please note:

Public examination results should be submitted before the end of August of each academic year or immediately after the publication of results.

Submitted results should be official. (I)GCSE equivalent results slip (photocopies by Notary or carrying current school stamp) for all pupils in English system or official end-of-year results for pupils not currently in the British system.

Selection Process

Selection Committee

All candidates' applications will be considered by a selection committee specifically set up by King's College.

Criteria

The committee will consider all aspects of the candidate's application.

A personal interview will also be required. The Committee will select candidates based on all the data received and will decide on the percentage of the scholarship to offer the candidate.

Final Decision

Once a final decision has been made, successful candidates will be informed as soon as possible. For pupils in the British system, final confirmation rests on their official (I)GCSE results in August and meeting any conditions in the scholarship award letter.

Unsuccessful candidates will be notified in writing as soon as possible.
